Message from Pietro Fiocchi

Pietro Fiocchi - President of Fiocchi of America



140 years is an amazing achievement for a small family owned business.

It all started with my Great-Grandfather Giulio Fiocchi in 1876. He was sent to Lecco as an accountant in order to close down an ailing black powder factory. After only a few days on the job, he fell in love with this business and decided to buy the company instead of closing it down. Even though he knew nothing about ammunition, he had sufficient vision to understand that black powder was a thing of the past and that he had to start investing in metallic ammunition and smokeless powder. As the famous 1st century Roman Consul, Giulio Cesare (same name, a coincidence?) once said: VENI, VIDI, VICI (I came, I saw, I conquered). Under his leadership, the factory started producing hundreds of different calibers, ranging from shotshell to centerfire and rimfire. Explosive production and primers were next.

There is a rich history of the Fiocchi Munizioni factory and its caretakers, and I can assure you that some of the stories I have heard from the second and third generation Fiocchi's were pretty amazing. Like the one of my uncle Pino (father of Carlo, sales director in FOA) who was tasked during WW2 to drive around in a horse drawn cart to buy all the iron and copper he could get his hands on in order to keep the production running. The amazing fact was that he was 12 year old! The war paradoxically created a strong link between the Fiocchi family and the US. We were dominated by the amazing US logistic and industrial capability and the second generation quickly realized that if we were going to be a contender in the ammunition business, we had to be in the US, fighting with the best in the field. So off they went, my father Paolo and my uncle Pino

(third generation) starting Alcan (later Smith&Wesson-Fiocchi) in the 60s. Two decades later, they founded Fiocchi of America in Ozark Missouri, still moving forward with a vision to become a respected name In the United States.

Nowadays, the fourth generation is running the business: Carlo and myself in the US, Costantino and Stefano in Italy. Fiocchi is present all over the world, but we continue to follow our ancestor's belief in the importance of a strong presence in the US.

What about the future? We will continue to invest heavily in the US , not only on the factory floor but with a continuation of our sponsorships.

Fiocchi of America provides support to many causes in the U.S.A., one of the most important is youth shooting events as they are the future of our country and industry. Fiocchi youth shooters are represented in all shooting disciplines and they are important ambassadors for both the shooting sports and their generation. Together with our youth sponsorships Fiocchi of America contributes to and participates in a number of other good causes, The Boy Scouts of America, Cancer Awareness and The Wounded Warrior Project...it's our way to give back to a great country that has given us so much in the past and that continues to give us so much.

As for the Fiocchi family, we are in the process of switching to the 5th generation. As family tradition warrants it, any member of the Fiocchi family that wants to work in the company must complete at least one year in production, possibly on the night shift and surely in the most uncomfortable departments. Without pay. Then he or she gets shipped around the world to gain experience in other companies. At last, provided that he or she show an uncommon passion for ammunition and a strong work ethic, we formally accept them in the company. I am getting ready to send my son Paolo to Argentina, for his "summer vacation in production".

As a closing remark, we recently had a big celebration party for Fiocchi Munizioni's 140's birthday. Every Fiocchi worker was invited (both present and retired), plus representatives from all the Fiocchi companies around the world (from as far as New Zealand), for a total of almost one thousand people. One retired worker looked at my 14 year old Daughter Maria Josè and told me: "She is going to be the President at the party for 200 years of Fiocchi".

I'll drink to that!

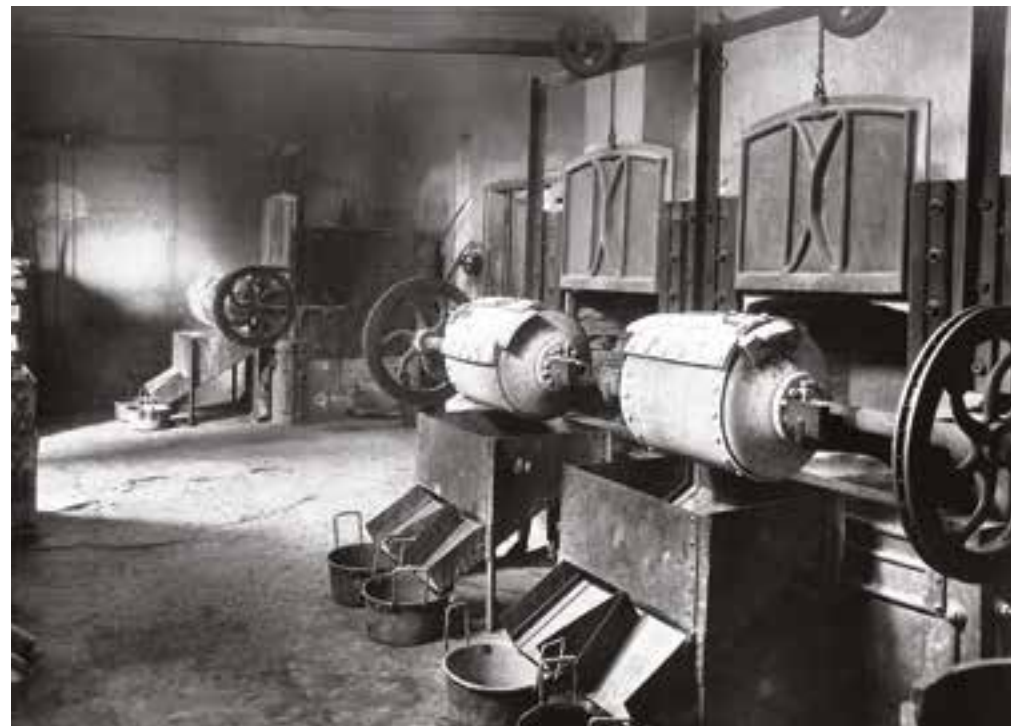

Luck and Risk in Lecco, Italy

Like a great Italian wine, an aged Barolo or Super Tuscan, for example, the history of Fiocchi Munizioni SpA, the parent company of Fiocchi USA, has many layers; layers denoting flavor, depth, unique style, workmanship and the whimsicality of fate. The company's formation was forged on the anvils of risk, vision and good fortune. In 1876 Giulio Fiocchi, a bank manager assigned to collect a defaulted loan from an arms and black powder manufacturer in Lecco, northeast of Milan, Italy, concluded that payment from the insolvent borrower was unlikely. Giulio and his brother, Giacomo, an engineer educated at the newly-founded University of Milan, were willing to risk that metallic case ammunition production could be profitable. Cased ammunition for breach loading firearms was in its infancy of development and they believed they could reconfigure the purchased company to create a viable ammunition business. They began producing hunting and sporting ammunition in 1877 under the name Giulio Fiocchi Enterprise, the predecessor of Fiocchi Munizioni SpA.

Then World War II occurred. The Nazi Wehrmacht seized the factory shortly after commencing. When defeat became imminent, the Nazis attempted to destroy the plant to keep it out of Allied control. Fiocchi workers thwarted the Nazis but British and American bombers almost totally destroyed the facilities. After the war the seven Fiocchi brothers faced a stark choice: go their separate ways or rebuild the several factories. They decided to rebuild. Assisted by their workforce of about fifteen hundred, the facilities were reconstructed in one year. The reconstructed factory was the beneficiary of new equipment of superior technology specifically designed for modern ammunition, much of it designed by Fiocchi engineers.

During one of our many conversations, Carlo Fiocchi, grandson of Giulio and current vice president of Fiocchi USA, explained that the consequent factory modernization gave Fiocchi an edge over other ammunition manufacturers in the 1950's and 60's. Fiocchi Munizioni currently has about five hundred and fifty employees. Annually it produces tens of millions of rounds of military ammunition, more than a billion shotgun primers, approximately seventy



million shotgun shells sold under its name and several hundred million empty primed cases for other manufacturers.

Still headquartered in Lecco, Fiocchi Munizioni SpA is owned wholly by the umbrella entity Giulio Fiocchi Holding. About sixty Fiocchi family members have shares in the holding company. Fiocchi USA is one of the international divisions wholly owned by Fiocchi Munizioni.

Fiocchi USA

Carlo Fiocchi joined the family business in 1980 at the age of 24. He traveled to the United States for both his honeymoon and to do marketing research for a US facility. He concluded that a physical presence in the United States for Fiocchi was necessary. In 1983 Fiocchi of America was created and a facility to import ammunition was built in Springfield, Missouri.

Realizing that the business model of only importing ammunition prevented the company from reacting sufficiently quickly to US needs, Carlo persuaded Fiocchi Munizioni to build a manufacturing plant near Springfield. After a period of independent consulting, Carlo returned to Fiocchi of America in 2005 and helped revitalizing a somewhat underperforming company.

Fiocchi of America was re-named Fiocchi USA and under Pietro's stewardship, the company has grown exponentially. "Now what was the baby is now as big as the mother company sales wise," Carlo said. He emphasizes his company's constant effort to learn and better understand the needs of the American market. The Italian

company helps and makes, in Carlo's words, "the most gallant efforts to make sure what was the little baby before continues to grow."

The American market is not limited to the United States. Fiocchi USA exports to Canada, Mexico, to Central and South America and to Australia and New Zealand. Fiocchi Munizioni exports to all customers in other countries. The efforts of Fiocchi Munizioni will enable Fiocchi USA to grow significantly. Although different mentalities exist between the Europe and the United States, Carlo says that a common identity has emerged like a butterfly from a cocoon that has led to a 1000% growth over the past ten years.

A Constant Effort To Improve

As Danny Ocean (George Clooney) bluntly said to Linus Caldwell (Matt Damon) when trying to recruit Linus in Ocean's Eleven, "Either you're in or you're out." Pietro grasps that the same brutal reality applies to the ammunition industry. "We cannot be a bystander in our own fate," Pietro told me. "We must create our future," he added.

Sales, company growth and customer satisfaction are not created by glossy magazine advertisements, although advertising is necessary. Fiocchi's 'boots on the ground' mentality propels it to engage directly with hunters and shooters of all disciplines and skill levels. The website www.fiocchiusa.com shows an array of products for niche markets such as Cowboy Action Line, the Law Enforcement Line, new rifle, pistol and shotgun loads, the new innovative 3 Gun Match line and technology-leading

advances in bullet lubrication.

Personal attention is one of Fiocchi's hallmarks. It makes particularized loads for an array of different environmental factors such as humidity, heat and cold. As if they were Michelin-rated chefs adjusting ingredients to their luscious sauces, Fiocchi engineers draw upon the needs and expertise of world-level competitors to craft these specialized loads. Competitors often visit the factory to track and test their customized ammunition.

This personalized approach generates the highest praise. For example, describing her greatest strength as a competitor during a World Cup in Munich, Francesco D'Aniello said: "I am 100% sure that the cartridges I put in my gun are exactly what I want. I have the perfect tools. Now it is all up to my concentration." Superstar clays shooter Anthony Matarese provides another illustration of personal engagement at the highest levels. Anthony told me "Carlo calls and asks how I'm doing. He seeks my thoughts on how to make better loads."

Fiocchi implements a holistic and interactive approach to customer service based on accessibility and high quality information. Its staff speaks with customers, seeks their advice and learns from their experiences. It is not an overstatement that the staff is obsessed with customer service. Troy Potter, for example, discuss technical issues and new product applications, always with the goal for making better products and fulfilling new demands. Fiocchi's ethos includes a sense of obligation to share information and, thereby, advance the sports by satisfying customers and bringing new shoot-

ers on board.

The most challenging aspect of his work, Carlo told me, was giving his company an identity. He wanted "something of a different flavor, a different perfume." Should you have the pleasure of speaking with any of the Fiocchi staff on either side of the ocean, you will know that a unique perfume pervades both companies. The sense of family encompasses the non-Fiocchi family workers. Jackie described how the mutual respect and affection among the staff inspires the drive toward excellence in all fields. Dee Zambetti describes working at Fiocchi USA as being at home. High praise indeed for a company!

Pietro phrased his dedication to excellence this way: "To put regular gas in a Ferrari is a capital sin. It's the same with putting mediocre ammunition in a top gun. And our name is on the friggin box! I cannot sell anything but the best. It's my Italian sense of pride".

Duty and Good Citizenship

I have interacted more with Fiocchi USA than Fiocchi Munizioni. I know it walks the walk, as the expression goes. It practices the noble creed that a duty to serve others is inherent in one's life; that there is a calling to a higher purpose. Fiocchi USA works with military veteran organizations to honor and acknowledge, in Carlo's words, "what they have done for the United States and, indeed, for the Western world." As an ex-airborne trooper, Carlo understands noble purposes, thus infusing his words with well-earned gravitas.

"Healthy mental gymnastics" is the phrase

used to express the virtues of the shooting sports. Mental discipline, self-control, perseverance, overcoming failure, respect for one's self, for others and for animals are all uplifting qualities that Fiocchi advances through their product lines and civic involvement. Shooting is more than shooting; ammunition is more than ammunition. They can be vessels for ethical betterment and achievement.

Beyond military organizations, Fiocchi's civic engagement extends to supporting programs including clay target competitors and events, youth programs, conservation organizations, 3-gun match programs and supporting Olympic rifle and pistol sports. Fiocchi USA partners with several of the finest shooting facilities in the United States such as the Beretta Shooting Grounds at Dover Furnace, New York. I share some personal experiences with Fiocchi USA. Jackie Stenton, Fiocchi USA Sales Office, has donated ammunition to events I have organized such as with The Wounded Warriors, The Paralyzed Veterans Association, Outdoor Buddies, a lady's day at the range and supplied products for many of my articles on disabled shooters, gun tests and gorgeous shotguns. Jackie has never refused my requests.

This article, for me, is more about a colleague and partner than about a company I visited and learned about. Even though the company has grown considerably since my first contact over a decade ago, it's always been a personal relationship. I have never felt that I was dealing with a large bureaucracy. I'd like to think of myself as special, but I doubt I am the only beneficiary of Jackie's and Fiocchi's generosity.

Crafting the Future

Leadership in Fiocchi Munizioni and Fiocchi USA is transferring from the fourth generation to the fifth. Irrespective of their relationships and education pedigree, family members will rise in the company based on work and achievement. The Fiocchi cousins welcome the generational transition and its inherent challenges. They have the humility to understand that they are, in Sir Isaac Newton's words, standing on the shoulders of giants; knowing that their success is based, in large measure, on the work and sacrifice their elders performed. They also know that Fiocchi has been through toxic times and survived. Survival is often Darwinian, and the survival and thriving of both companies means that positive forces have propelled the companies toward the future. Like violin string resonating honor, service and excellence across a century and across an ocean, the harmony indicates that the Fiocchi companies have done many things right. Now, as Pietro told me, "the past is behind our shoulders and we have a strong base for going forward into the future."

One of the most powerful messages Fiocchi sends to the world is that continuous growth will occur as a consequence of its technical advances, investments in production equipment, loading equipment for center fire and shotshell ammunition, priming equipment and components production. By investing on both sides of the 'pond,' both companies synchronize their efforts to attain success in all departments. "We must make sure that the future of the group is a shining one" Pietro said. "If you are not willing to learn, to be humble, then you face disaster.

We are willing to learn."

Fiocchi's Soul

Fiocchi's story illustrates the triumph of will and having the grit and fortitude to risk taking advantage of opportunity. Fiocchi Munizioni rose from rubble, survived the Nazis and Allied bombing and earned being the recipient of extraordinary worker loyalty in Post War Italy and then in the United States. All these events comprise an epic narrative.

In modern times, a family business surviving one hundred and forty years is a rare achievement. Businesses fail for many reasons—incompetent management, intra-family conflict, market changes, greed and stupidity. Focchi Munizioni SpA. has survived and prospered. It

stands nearly alone in accomplishment.

Fiocchi Munizioni and Fiocchi USA have elevated the worlds of hunting, self-defense and sport shooting for 140 years. That's not quite at Beretta's unique five-hundred-year mark, but I believe, and I certainly hope, that the Fiocchi companies are solidly on their way. For nearly a century and a half, Fiocchi companies have unceasingly helped the young, the disabled, those that defend us, those that need defending and those that love to hunt and shoot. Quite an accomplishment.

With friendship and boundless respect, I wish Fiocchi Munizioni "Happy 140th Anniversary!"





Fiocchi Continues PSCA Support

PSCA brings insight into what the shooters are thinking and what strategies they are likely to employ. The large raucous crowds, running commentary, and nerves can get to even the most seasoned shooter.

Fiocchi Ammunition was an inaugural sponsor of the Professional Sporting Clays Association (PSCA) in 2014 and continued that support for the 2015 sophomore season. The PSCA provides a format for tour professionals to compete for cash prizes and be a part of a television program designed to increase awareness and participation in the shotgun target sports. Major changes were made to the PSCA format in 2015 in order to allow amateurs to qualify for prizes and make the televised portion of the program more exciting. Long time professional sporting clays shooter Scott Robertson was named President of the PSCA, Scott brings his years of shooting, television hosting, and range management expertise to the organization. The biggest change for 2015 being the introduction of Robertson's Pro Challenge format for the event finals.

In 2015 52 PSCA pro tour cards were issued for male competitors and 12 for female competitors. Tour pros and amateur challengers shoot an initial Qualification Round on a 120 target sporting clays course. The targets on

these Qualification Rounds are by necessity fairly tough and not for the faint of heart. At the conclusion of the Qualification Round the top 12 male tour pros and top 4 women pros automatically advance to the PSCA Pro Challenge round. Four additional spots are available for the men in order to make up 8 brackets of 16 shooters. After taking out the top 12 tour pro scores who automatically advance, the next 16 scores, either pros or amateur challengers, compete in a Pro Challenge bracket for the remaining 4 men's positions in a Last Chance Qualifier. The next top 4 ladies scores, either pro or amateur, after taking out the top 4 female pros who automatically advance, move up to a 4 bracket 8 ladies PSCA Pro Challenge.

The PSCA Pro Challenge provides a fast paced, head to head competition shot at night under stadium lights in front of a live audience with White Flyer Orange Crush flash targets. The PSCA Pro Challenge competition consists of 4 number 1 targets and targets 2-7 that increase in difficulty. Competitors shoot



side by side with the highest seeded shooter going first. The first frame of the competition requires the competitors to each shoot a random 1 target along with the next target in numerical order, 1-2, 1-3, etc. through 7 on report. The number 1 target must be broken in order to score the next target, scores equal the value of the target. The second frame of competition is a speed round consisting of all of the number 1 birds and the number 2 in random order with a 4 second interval between targets. The second speed round is the 3 target through 7 in numerical order with a 4 second interval. Competitors can reload as often as possible in the speed rounds, with each target hit in the speed rounds worth 4 points. The final round allows the competitor to call for report pairs of targets 2 through 7, with the 4 and 5 target allowed only once per shooter. The lower value target must be hit in order to score the second target, the score is the actual target value. The final round offers the opportunity for a shooter to gamble on higher value pairs to advance his score or play it conservative.

Event #1

Another major change for the 2015 tour season was to host PSCA events at major National Sporting Clays Association (NSCA) events. Easing the travel and logistics challenges of putting on separate events while opening up the opportunity for more amateurs to qualify and experience the Pro Challenge format. Tour stop number one was the 700 acre

Northbrook Sports Club in Hainesville, IL, an hour and a half north of Chicago. This PSCA event was held in conjunction with the NSCA U.S. Open in late June. The 120 bird qualifier was laid out on virgin ground on the western edge of the property with targets set by Promatic's Heyward Cunningham. The top PSCA pro after the qualifier was 2014 top money earner Gebben Miles shooting 113, Matt Fisher was the top amateur with a 109 for the men. Amateur lady Janet McDougall, CFO of Blaser USA, bested all of the female pros with a score of 100. Pro Jenni Clark was second with a 98 out of 120.

The wind and light rain didn't deter a huge gallery from attending the debut of the PSCA Pro Challenge under the lights in the stadium. A meet and greet the pros autograph session is held before each event, giving fans the opportunity to speak with their favorite shooters. T-shirts are also thrown out into the crowd, bringing a higher energy form of entertainment to the shooting sports. Scott Robertson as master of ceremony provided a running commentary on the competition. Large television monitors provide the audience with real time scoring courtesy of Shoot Technology Solutions, keeping the fans fully engaged and up to date. The men's final saw Mike Wilgus go up against Brandon Powell with Powell going home with \$10,000.00 as PSCA Event #1 Champion. Amateur challenger for 2015 Alexandra Wampler faced 2014 Ladies Champion of Champions Desirae Edmunds, Wampler

took the Ladies Championship and \$2,000.00. The speed rounds certainly added excitement to the event as competitors bobbled reloads and had to develop a reload strategy. Most chose to reload after each shot, if possible, to eliminate having to handle two shells at once.

Event #2

Event #2 saw the PSCA travel to the 1,000 acre Caribou Gun Club in LeSueur, MN during the World FITASC shoot in late July. Caribou offers a surprising variety of terrain from woods, fields, and some steep contours allowing for some interesting shots below your feet. Competitors from all over the world were in attendance for the World FITASC and many signed up to give the PSCA qualifier a go. Ben Husthwaite from the UK was the top qualifier with a score of 110 out of 120. Ladies tour pro Carolyn Smith tied with amateur Alexandra Wampler on 97. The 2014 Nad Al Sheba Ladies Champion Beatriz Laparra from Spain qualified with a score of 89. A little translation help was needed to go over the PSCA Pro Challenge rules, but after watching a few rounds of competition Laparra was ready to go. Unfortunately the speed rounds tripped up Laparra with a lack of experience quickly reloading knocking her out of contention.

A packed stadium with a truly international representation was in attendance for the finals under the lights. After a long day of tough competition many of the competitors struggled under the lights with the number 1

targets. Doug Vine and Mike Wilgus ended up in the men's finals with Vine walking away the Champion. Tour pro Desirae Edmunds ended up going head to head with amateur DeeAnn Massey, Edmunds came out on top as Ladies Champion for Event #2. This event was great exposure for the PSCA and its sponsors to an international audience. Local newspaper and television coverage provided positive shooting sports exposure to the community. These events also bring a huge positive economic impact to the local area hotels, restaurants, gas stations, etc.

Event #3

Event #3 had the PSCA travel southward to Big Red Oak Plantation in Gay, GA an hour and a half south of Atlanta. Event #3 was held in conjunction with the NSCA Southeast Regional in early August. Big Red Oak Plantation offers 2,500 acres of typical southern bobwhite quail plantation terrain and vegetation, gently rolling hills with oak and pine trees. The PSCA qualifying course was laid out among this scenic terrain. Local Georgia shooter and tour pro Clint Hinton posted the top score of 107, Desirae Edmunds topped all of the ladies with a 92 out of 120. The PSCA hired Greg Connell to put on an amazing air show with his Wolf Pitts biplane as part of the Friday entertainment. Scott Robertson also put on his trick shooting exhibition, playing to a packed house. Once the sun finally set it was time for the Pro Challenge under the lights. The final men's pairing saw tour pros David Radulovich



and local Georgian Will Hinton battle it out. After the clay dust had settled Radulovich was Event #3 men's Champion. The ladies final was a bit of a surprise with tour pro Candice Fowler going up against amateur challenger Grace Callahan, with Callahan securing the ladies Champion title and prize fund.

Event #4

PSCA Event #4 and the Champion of Champions Fiocchi Cup events were scheduled to occur during the NSCA National Championships at the National Shooting Complex in San Antonio, TX in late October. The Nationals Main Event had over 1,600 shooters, no other shoot could expose the PSCA to this many shooters other than the Nationals. During a lull in the Main Event shooting on Wednesday October 21st the PSCA qualifying course was overlaid on portions of the Main Event Green and Orange courses. One hundred and thirty four shooters attempted to qualify. Tour pro Theo Ribbs burned up the course with a 115 out of 120, tour pros Brad Kidd and Wendell Cherry both tied on 113. Ladies tour pros Desirae Edmunds and Jenni Clark tied on 97 with amateur Alexandra Wampler with 96 out of 120. Hurricane Patricia started to effect the weather in San Antonio on Wednesday with winds and intermittent rain.

The Last Chance Qualifier was concluded on Wednesday the 21st as well as shooting down the ladies bracket to the final two. The men's championship bracket was shot down to the

final 4 competitors on Thursday the 23rd. The championship round was held on Saturday October 24th in the shoot off stadium under the lights with blustery winds from the hurricane and dropping temperatures. Newcomer Grace Callahan found herself up against seasoned tour pro Desirae Edmunds who dominated the 2014 ladies division and had a solid 2015 season so far. Both Edmunds and Callahan had moved through their respective brackets fairly handily. Edmunds wouldn't let up and she defeated Callahan 75 to 46 to become the 2015 Event #4 Ladies Champion, her second win for the year.

The final four men shooting in the stadium were all tour pros, Shawn Kemeter would face Zach Kienbaum and Wendell Cherry would oppose Gebben Miles. Kemeter squeaked by Kienbaum 86 to 83 while Cherry defeated Miles 95 to 76. The men's finals saw a back and forth battle between Kemeter and Cherry with the decision coming down to the final pair. Cherry eased by Kemeter 76 to 75 to become Event #4 Men's Champion.

Champion of Champions Fiocchi Cup
Immediately following Event #4 shooters assembled for the Champion of Champions Fiocchi Cup. This event is comprised of a bracketed PSCA Pro Challenge competition featuring the top 8 men and top 4 women PSCA tour point earners. The top 2015 tour point earning men were Gebben Miles, Brad Kidd, David Radulovich, Derrick Mein, Mike

Wilgus, Wendell Cherry, Kevin DeMichiel, and Doug Vine. The top ladies were Desirae Edmunds, Grace Callahan, Jenni Clark, and Alexandra Wampler. Callahan was again matched up against Edmunds with Clark facing Wampler. Clark and Edmunds advanced to the final and after a steady back and forth Edmunds emerged the ladies Champion of Champions defeating Clark 59 to 45. The men's final came down to Wendell Cherry vs 2014 Champion of Champions Gebben Miles. After a tough fought match Miles bested Cherry 74 to 69 to be crowned the men's Champion of Champions. The Fiocchi Cup presented by Carlo Fiocchi is a perpetual traveling cup with each winners names engraved on the cup.

These events will make for some exciting television when the programs are broadcast in 2016 on the Sportsman Channel and they provided great entertainment for those in the stands. The PSCA Pro Challenge format brings an exciting new dynamic with speed rounds and the introduction of strategy in target selection during the final round. The running commentary of Scott Robertson brings insight into what the shooters are thinking and what strategies they are likely to employ. The large raucous crowds, running commentary, and nerves can get to even the most seasoned shooter. Examples were fumbled reloads, forgetting to stage enough ammunition for the speed rounds, and forgetting to reload at all. The PSCA could not exist without the

generous support of major sponsors like Fiocchi Ammunition, to help support both organizations Fiocchi offers a PSCA branded line of shotgun shells. The 2016 PSCA tour season will be even bigger and better with exciting head to head shooting featuring some of the best shooters in the world.



FIOCCHI CUP

Once again, Fiocchi sponsored a first class event and the management and staff at Ben Avery Target Center did a great job – perfect weather, great targets and a festive atmosphere.

Al Hague reports from Ben Avery in Phoenix, Arizona

Over 300 competitors made the trip to Arizona for the 2015 Fiocchi Cup. Hosted by Ben Avery Clay Target Center, they enjoyed perfect shooting conditions with temperatures in the high 70s with mild winds which made for some great scores.

Fiocchi Ammunition made available more than \$25,000 in cash and prizes for their flagship event, which offered a substantial menu of shooting for those who had the appetite. Each day had a 5-Stand competition along with sub gauge events, Super Sporting, FITASC, a 100 target Prelim on the Friday and a 200 bird Main Event shot over the two days of the weekend.

The Ben Avery Clay Target Center is owned and managed by the Arizona Game and Fish Department which can host pretty much any size event. The sporting clays facilities offer two courses, each of 15 stations, with plenty of space to expand the venue for special events when necessary. The Super Sporting and sub gauge events were shot on separate courses, preventing conflicts for scheduling or slow rotation issues.

Prelim
218 shooters hit the course for the 2015 Fiocchi Cup Prelim on the Rattlesnake Course. Scores were impressive – it was a great warm-up for the Main to come at the weekend. Mike Wilgus, who has been shooting extremely well pretty much all year, dropped just one target taking HOA. One back at 98 was Perry Miller. Four ties at 97 were decided by tie-breaker stations. Daniel Knecht took M1 followed by Gebben Miles (M2) and Mark Johnson (M3). Raymond Brown, a Fiocchi sponsored shooter and member of last year's Team All-American took M4. Class AA1 through AA3 all posted 94s with Ben Courtemarche at the top followed by Tom Stack and Timothy Foster. Lady Champion was Candice Fowler with her 88, two ahead of strong shooting Dee Zambetti from Fiocchi.

Stand
The 5-Stand events were set up on the trap over-lays spread out along the trap line. A wide selection of target presentations made for some fun, exciting and challenging shooting for most, but as usual, the top shooters were all close in final scores.

Thursday saw the first of the four 5-Stand competitions, won handily by Jon Kruger, missing only one target. Two back was Mark Johnson while Michael Willard (M1) posted 47. Friday, Saturday and Sunday 5-Stand events saw Mike Wilgus take HOA in all three events, only dropping a total of nine targets from 150 targets over the three days.

Super Sporting and Sub Gauge
Super Sporting was a 50 target event won by Nicholas J. Kraus with a 49, the same score as runner-up Richard Hoyt. One back was Tyler Encinas (M1) and Mike Wilgus (M2). The event attracted 184 shooters reflecting the growing popularity of this discipline.

Jon Kruger with his usual solid shooting took both the 20ga and 28ga events with scores of 46 and 48 respectively. The .410 Champion was Mark Johnson with a strong 48 with David Gallagher in as runner-up back at 44.

FITASC
The FITASC was laid out among the bushes and cactus and on one layout utilized a high earthen berm that created some very tough downhill shots of longer than average distance. Targets were set by Dan Twitchell and his team and by most accounts they were entertaining but tricky. Even so, most of the top shots came through and were able to post solid scores on a difficult course. Andy Duffy lead the field with a 92 for a while, but on the last day, Gebben Miles posted a 95 to take HOA – his second

consecutive Fiocchi Cup FITASC title. Duffy was runner-up and Aaron Aslanian took M1 with a 91.

Main Event
The race for the Fiocchi Cup on Saturday had two top shots tied with 97s but shot on different courses – Mike Wilgus on the Roadrunner Course and Gebben Miles on the Rattlesnake Course.

On Sunday, Wilgus posted a brilliant 99 for a 196 total, while Miles could only manage a 95 for a total of 193/200. This was the third straight year that Wilgus has won this event. He's had an amazing year, winning the Masters at M&M, the Montana, Idaho and Washington State Championships and a second win of the US Open.

In other classes and concurrents, winners were Ben Courtemarche (AA – 187), Zakery Speir (A – 168), Joe Zerr (B – 173), Michael Klonoski (C – 168), Lucas Pieraccini (D – 167), Blaise Klen-ske (E – 165), Candice Fowler (L – 180), Damian Gardiner (SJ – 186), Caston Calusen (J – 187), Mark Leresche (V – 190), William Becker (SV – 186) and Gary McStay (SSV – 177).

Summary
Perhaps one of the reasons for the growth of this event is the extra mile Fiocchi goes to to entertain and create a fun event for shooters. On Saturday, a catered dinner was served after which raffle prizes were drawn. Every shooter

was provided a ticket for the drawings that included cases of shells, gear bags and clothing. Fiocchi made sure the Sub-Juniors and Juniors were all given gifts to make their experience memorable.

After the dinner and raffle prizes, shooters were given the opportunity to join the fun of Gnat Warfare. Each aircraft is equipped with flash powder pods attached to the underside of the wings and when hit by shot the pod explodes. Score is determined by how many pods were hit by the shooting teams once the plane has landed. The aircraft travels at excess of 50 MPH so a significant lead is required to hit them – it's a fun event to shoot in but also very entertaining for the audience.

Once again, Fiocchi sponsored a first class event and the management and staff at Ben Avery Target Center did a great job – perfect weather, great targets and a festive atmosphere. The Fiocchi staff of Carlo Fiocchi, Dee Zambetti, Christine Qualm, John Zambetti and Adam Pinto should be complemented.



IPSC Shotgun World Shoot II

The ladies of the 2015 USA Standard Team had a high degree of success in both cases, with Lena Miculek winning Gold, Di Muller winning Silver, and both myself and Becky Yackley qualifying for the top eight shoot-off with 5th and 6th place finishes.

Over 650 competitors, including 74 National Teams, traveled to the beautiful Le Te Piume range in Agna, Italy for the IPSC Shotgun World Shoot II. The main match was a five day, Monday through Friday affair, followed by a shoot-off on Sunday for top finishers, including the top eight women. I had the privilege of being a member of the USA Ladies Standard Team, along with my daughter Lena Miculek, Diana (Di) Muller and Becky Yackley.

The entire team was pleased when we were informed that Fiocchi Ammunition was going to be the ammunition sponsor for the World Shoot. Having participated in eight previous World Shoots (both Handgun and Shotgun World Shoots), I was familiar with the trails and tribulations sometimes associated with getting quality ammunition at these events. As members of Team Fiocchi of America, we had no worries when we learned that we were going to have access to the same dependable Fiocchi shotshells that we had used to earn a place on the USA Team.

All of the ladies on the team shoot primarily Multi-Gun competitions. However, previous to the Shotgun World Shoot, we made an effort to participate in as many shotgun-only events as possible, and managed to arrange several team practice sessions as well. Even with our

added focus on shotgun events, it took some of us several stages to get the hang of the IPSC/European style stages of fire. The primary difference between US style stages and IPSC/European style stages is the abundance and close proximity of no-shoot targets. Many of the scoring targets that must be engaged are partially covered by a no-shoot target. With a 10 second penalty assessed if a no-shoot target is knocked down, it is imperative that the shooter be very familiar with shot pattern sizes at all distances. With this knowledge the shooter must then determine where to aim in order to knock down the scoring target without also knocking down the no-shoot target. Sometimes the margin for error is very slim.

This more precise style of shotgun shooting is quite different from the wide open, run-and-gun style stages that are prevalent at competitions in the US, but the US Ladies Team adapted and their efforts earned them a Gold Medal Team finish. In the individual race, Lena Miculek's match winning performance earned her a Gold Medal and Di Muller took the Silver Medal. With 5th and 6th place finishes for Kay Miculek and Becky Yackley, an added bonus was that all four US team members qualified for the Top Eight shoot-off. After winning their first bout against shooters from Italy, Russia, and England, all four US

ladies advanced to make the semi-finals an all-American affair, with Lena again taking top honors. I originally intended to compete at IPSC Shotgun World Shoot II as the lone American woman in Open Division. However, when a spot became available, I made the switch to Standard Division so that I could be a part of the USA Ladies Standard Team. I have always found the dynamics of competing as a team the most fun and rewarding aspect of the IPSC World Shoot competitions. I have been on eight World Shoot teams, and have always found it interesting and entertaining when four alpha females are pitted against each other for the individual title, but at the same time are working together to insure that their combined efforts result in the highest possible team score. The ladies of the 2015 USA Standard Team had a high degree of success in both cases, with Lena Miculek

winning Gold, Di Muller winning Silver, and both myself and Becky Yackley qualifying for the top eight shoot-off with 5th and 6th place finishes. I loved shooting with all of the ladies on the USA Ladies Standard Team, but I must admit that it was a special treat for me to be able to compete on the same team as my daughter Lena. At the first IPSC Shotgun World Shoot I coached Lena through every stage. Just three years later, the student has become the master, and more often than not, it was me asking Lena for advice. In 1993 at the IPSC Handgun World Shoot, I won the individual Gold Medal and led the USA Ladies Team to a Gold Medal victory. Twenty-two years later, my daughter wins the individual Gold and leads the USA ladies team, of which I am a member, to a Gold Medal victory. How cool is that?!

The Fiocchi buckshot for World Shoot was giving us a consistent and tight pattern.

My experience in Italy was probably a little different than most...I stayed in a house with the USA Junior Team (Katelyn Francis, Tim Yackley, Nate Staskiewicz, and Brian Hampton) because my son was one of the team members. Not only did I get to see Italy through the eyes of the younger group and their parents, I was able to see the match through their eyes as well. Some of the stages were challenging in their technicality, with no-shoots set very close to shoot targets. This made choke selection and shooting positions important, more than what we were all accustomed to. Some of the stages were really fun, such as shooting off the back of a "horse" at poppers and clays as fast as you could...at least, that was what Katie and I figured the hit factor and points for the stage dictated.

The help that Riccardo Cassin from Fiocchi Italy gave us played a role in our teams having a less stressful morning the day of check in and practice. The junior team was hurrying over to the practice range, the rest of the ladies were checking in, and I was through the line, so I met Rick and he arranged for the pallet-sized load to be brought right to the vehicle. He was also very sincere in his interest and sought us out to ask how the ammo ran for us during the match.

Once we had our ammo and patterned it, I think we all breathed a sigh of relief, as just the travel was something of a monumental accomplishment. Mine and my sons guns were a day late, have been waylaid by the black hole of the Chicago, O'Hare airport. I purchased the Fiocchi ammo that my son Tim shot in the match. We had to work with the 32gram loads because we are shooting for Stoeger and the guns need loads that are heavier. The buckshot was a surprise for us because when we went to pattern it during practice, it patterned very well through our full choke. Where other buckshot had been giving us a "flyer" the Fiocchi buck for World Shoot was giving us a consistent and tight pattern. I brought home all I could! I was talking with Jerry Miculek about it at a rifle match a week later and showed him the buckshot. He said it was the way it was stacked that made such a uniform pattern. He even took one because it sounded like he wanted to talk to Fiocchi about it.

The birdshot was size 6 shot, which was a bit larger than what we are used to, and it patterned in our full choke nearly double what the 7.5 once and an 8th of shot in AA pattern...but it still was great to have ammo supplied to the match so that we could make arrangements ahead of time!

One of the parts that I loved about the match was the food - there was espresso in the morning, croissants filled with warm apple filling, ice cream bars I took a photo of...definitely not the match food I am used to! Then there was a great lunch, with pasta. And at the end of the day, people stopped to have a drink and talk. Everyone wanted to meet you and everyone wanted to share their story. We tried out the magnetic shell holders that the Finns brought, traded jerseys and shirts with the Finns, Russians, and the team from Thailand.

When we returned from the range each day, I was the cook at our house. So after we ate, the junior team and I looked at the stages for the next day and talked about stage plans. Right up to the last night, before the shoot-off. I was practicing loading for the shoot off and they were giving me feedback. The next morning, we arrived at the range and were told there was going to be a junior shoot off, so the fact that they'd all watched and talked with me about my plan and discussed strategy was good - they now had a plan.

The one experience that I took to heart the most happened when we were leaving Italy...I was the first of the ladies and juniors to go through the police office with my shotgun and fill out the paperwork. There was a space for a permit number. Not our import/export permit, but one you would need if you lived in Italy. I told them that I am not required to have a permit, and I jokingly asked if I could write "the 2nd amendment" as my permit. The Italians did not understand. It really hit me right then what it means to have the rights that we do as Americans and how much being a visible part of that heritage is important.

We can't thank Fiocchi enough for their role in the USA Ladies Standard Team's success!

A woman's journey into the shooting sports

Women are encouraging the other women in their lives to join in the fun, and this natural networking works to exponentially grow not only the shooting sports, but also the community of responsible American gun owners as a whole.

These are exciting times. I am seeing thousands of new women embracing gun ownership every month. Most of them come with a hunger to become the best self-protectors they can be in a world that now demands that each and every one of us take the personal responsibility for our own safety and security. Unfortunately it is no longer possible for women to outsource this critical responsibility — the days of believing that the men in our lives can be our “knights in shining armor” or that law enforcement will always be within reach to protect us are long gone. Women are flocking to The Well Armed Woman and to gun ownership because they are tired of being ‘easy prey’. A beautiful thing happens as they grow into this new role — the fear that spurred them to gun ownership in the first place turns to confidence as they take charge of their own safety, and that in turn leads to the discovery of the shooting sports and a whole new world of exciting challenges. So, what is born in fear leads to an empowered new life of independence and fun!

I am blessed to witness this transition first hand every day, but it is not always an easy one. There are many difficult hurdles for women

along this journey. The ugliness of violence is a tough reality to accept, but it is one that we may have to face one day. There is the sometimes difficult soul searching that must be gone through to determine if we could in fact, take the life of another to save our own. As traditional “life givers” this can be a significant personal decision. Many of us are raised to fear guns, and need to overcome that as well before moving forward. Once these hurdles are cleared, it is time to learn about guns, their safe handling, their legal use, and the fundamentals of shooting. It is here, at this stage that the metamorphosis really begins. The fears slowly melt away as women learn that they can handle and shoot a gun proficiently. With the mastery of these skills comes a sense of confidence that they carry with them well beyond the shooting range. An independence and strength emerges and can be seen in every aspect of the daily lives of these newly empowered self-protectors.

With fears overcome and mastery of the firearm complete, the doorways to the many opportunities within the shooting sports open wide. Who knew there was so much fun to be had and so many different disciplines to

choose from? Truly, there is a smorgasbord for the hungry shooter and women shooters are filling their plates! There are handgun sports, such as action shooting IDPA (International Defensive Pistol Association) USPSA (United States Practical Shooting Association) NRA Shooting Sports, CMSA (Cowboy Mounted Shooting Association) SASS (Single Action Shooting Society) USA Shooting, and ISSF (International Shooting Sports Federation). There are shotgun sports such as Trap, Skeet and Sporting Clays with great organizations such as ATA (Amateur Trapshooting Association) NNSA (National Skeet Shooting Association) and NSCA (National Sporting Clays Association). For rifle shooters there are bench rest competitions with the NBRSA (National Bench Rest Shooters Association), silhouette and position shooting competitions with the NRA Shooting Sports and ISSF (International Shooting Sports Federation). These, along with the plethora of hunting opportunities, offer women endless choices.

What make this even more beautiful are the open arms that these organizations and shooting communities extend to new competitive shooters. What I hear most often from women entering the shooting sports is just how friendly and helpful everyone is to them and that they feel very welcomed. They realize they don't have to be Olympic level shooters to participate and that there are many opportunities for shooters of every skill level.

A recent report compiled by the National Shooting Sports Foundation (NSSF) found that 74% of retailers are reporting an increase in female customers, and according to the National Sporting Goods Association, female engagement in target shooting grew 60 percent to 5.4 million participants between 2001 and 2013. It was up 85 percent for hunting, at 3.3 million participants during that same period.

Women are encouraging the other women in their lives to join in the fun, and this natural networking works to exponentially grow not only the shooting sports, but also the community of responsible American gun owners as a whole. I am a firm believer that if mom is shooting, the whole family is shooting, which not only creates a healthy recreational activity for the whole family, but helps to raise up the next generation of responsible gun owners who, with a full understanding and respect for our Second Amendment, will grow up to actively protect it. I see women becoming engaged in political issues like never before. Women are now taking an active part in the gun rights political discussion, which was once a conversation held primarily by men, and going forward we will play a significant role in influencing policy decisions.

I became a hunter when I watched my first German Wirehaired Pointer work a field, slam into a quivering point, then watch as a pheasant towered skyward. I’d never owned a gun before, but decided if he would do that for me, the least I could do is shoot the bird for him. Little did I know that was the start of a life-long series of dazzling performances by hundreds of magical dogs I was privileged to live with, hunt with, and watch over the years, at home, hunting “for fun,” and on my television series, Wing-shooting USA. Lucky for me, the relationship continues with my current dogs Buddy and Manny. The awe I felt from that first point returns every time I send one of them into the field. Beyond a book’s-worth of wisdom dogs have shared with me, I learned a bit on my own, including the importance of good ammunition. After the training’s complete, it’s time to hunt. That is not the time to disappoint a dog with a miss. And while accuracy is critical, so is the quality of the shell you put in the chamber as your bug-eyed dog slowly swivels his head toward you while pointing a skittering bobwhite covey. Fiocchi delivers. Read the rest of this catalog to learn more about how. But trust me, when the cameras are rolling and the dogs are going the extra mile, Fiocchi ammunition is the best insurance policy for putting birds in the bag.

Any excuse for sharing time with a dog is legitimate. This is an explosive sport, in more than just the literal sense. The landscape of 3-Gun is changing among participants. The sport and its’ image has grown and morphed radically over the past several years. From juniors to exclusive women 3-Gun shoots to equal male/female matches as the one mentioned below:

“Female friendly, male inclusive! The first of its’ kind, the Babes with Bullets 3-Gun Challenge is a two Domain match. Our goal is to have an equal number of female and male participants. All competitors will shoot the same stages of fire, with the Women’s Domain and Men’s Domain scored separately. Initially there will be 100 slots reserved for each Domain.

Cross-over shooting skills. Shooting a little 3-gun myself, I can see the cross-over into other shooting disciplines, and therefore the wide appeal. I began shooting clay target sports years ago and gradually got into revolver, and eventually moved over to the “dark side” shooting action pistol and IPSC matches. Each discipline seems to attract a slightly different crowd. 3-Gun seems to appeal to the pistol and rifle shooters while implementing some action shotgun skills, which are not your typical clay sporting shots!

As I started hunting more this year, I found there are skills used in 3-Gun that made me more confident in the field, quicker mounting the gun, getting on target, and working in tight shots and sometimes uncomfortable positions. So you find all disciplines and skill levels that 3-Gun appeals to.

There’s constant movement through the stages, lots of action and reactionary targets and a lot of strategy involved! Reloading speed and skill is key to a good run on your stage. Practice reloading on the move, your motion needs to be fluid, and smooth transitions from target to target and from each weapon change over.



Shot cadence from target to target, squeezing the trigger instead of “slapping”, even your foot placement and way you walk/run through the stage all have techniques that are practiced and honed to shave a second here and second there off your overall time. Each stage during a match will have a timed “walk-through” period.

You want to know which targets to take first, how many shots needed, when and where to drop and change your mags or to speed load your shotgun so as not to stop and start while running your stage. You need to learn how to “call your shots”, being able to trust with reasonable certainty as you don’t have time to hesitate and sometimes cannot see to confirm your hits.

With so much strategy and techniques to combine, you don’t want to be worrying about your equipment and ammo! You absolutely need to rely on those functioning flawlessly! You can’t guarantee your technique will be flawless, but you certainly have some control in choosing your equipment and ammo for the best performance possible! “
